

# Responding to Disclosures of Sexual Misconduct

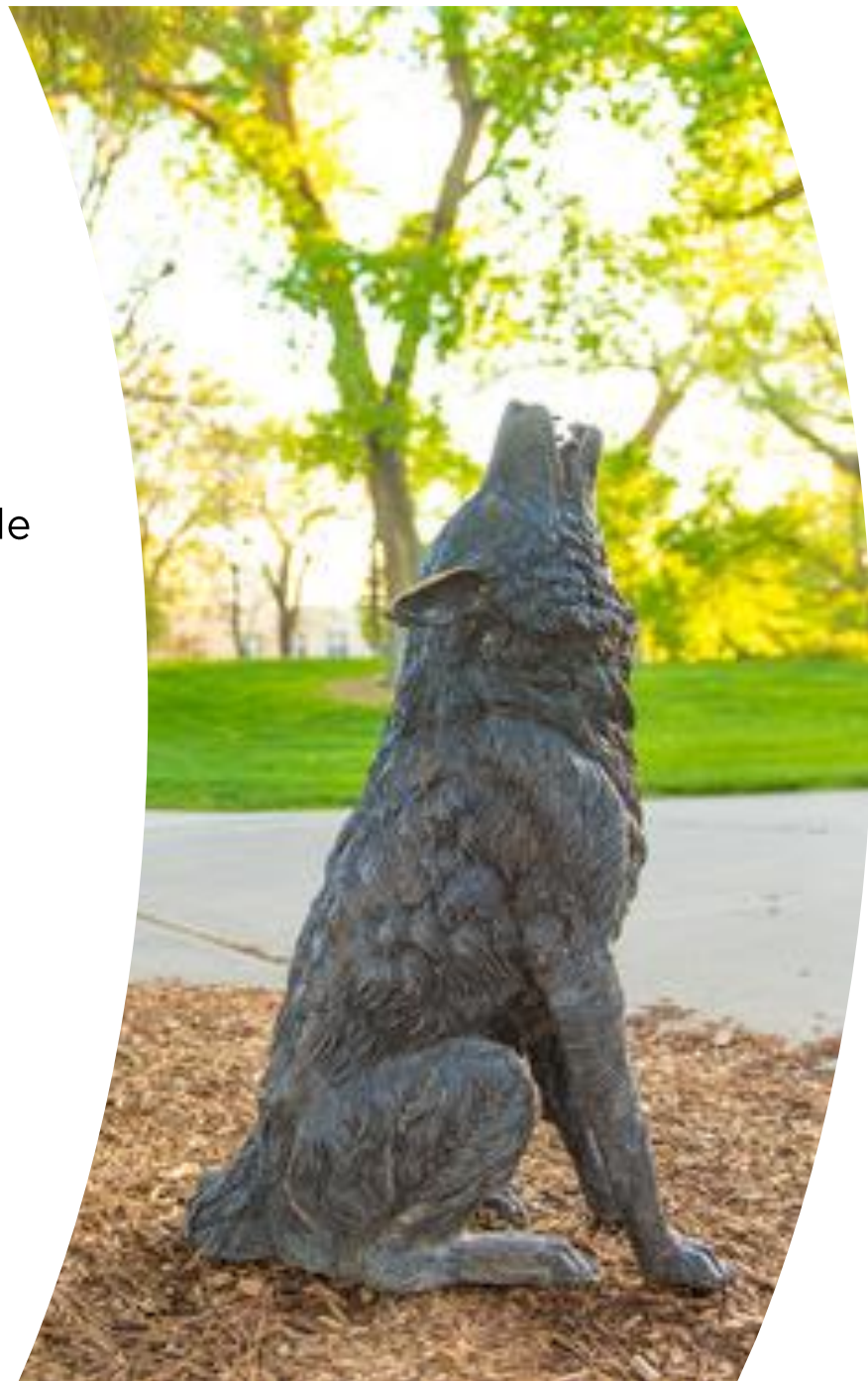
When someone discloses they have been impacted by sexual misconduct, remember SILVER.
